After answering each question thoroughly, please attach the questions and answers to your online "Risk Assessments Performed Using the Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA") Vulnerability Self Assessment Tool ("VSAT") 6.0" SAFETY Act Block Designation Application. The failure to provide the required information will result in an Incompleteness Letter, and require you to resubmit your application.

Please be advised that, for the purposes of the SAFETY Act, and the questions contained in the application, the term "Technology" refers to your Risk Assessment Performed Using the EPA VSAT 6.0. **If you have trouble with this process please call the Help Desk at 1-866-788-9318.**

Please answer all required questions in the Block Designation application, including providing all necessary insurance and financial information. Failure to do so may result in an application that cannot be processed expeditiously.
