

Contour Information

As a part of your SAFETY Act Award, you may have what is known as a “contour.” A contour is either a continuing or one-time reporting requirement. Because the types of contours are so varied, if you receive a notification from www.safetyact.gov that a response to a contour is pending, **please consult your award decision for specific details.** The information below is provided ***for instructional use only.*** If you have specific questions about your contour that are not addressed by this document, please contact the Office of SAFETY Act Implementation at (866)-788-9318 or helpdesk@safetyact.gov.

Technical Contours

1. Details about technical contours can be found in your award decision under “Other Conditions.” Please review this section as it will outline additional documents that will need to be submitted for review at regular intervals or other technical reporting requirements.
2. When submitting documents in response to your contour, we suggest providing a summary listing of documents, as well as a cover memorandum outlining (in brief) the relevance of the supporting materials. Again, this is as appropriate and should be brief, providing you the opportunity to explain the relevance of your attached documents and how they impact your contour requirements.
3. If your contour requirement requires you to provide a point of contact (test plan or test data is held by a third-party), please contact those points of contact in advance of submitting your response.

Economic Contours

1. If you received your award prior to October 2007, your contour requirement is part of your insurance requirement.
2. If you received your award after October 2007, your contour requirement is listed as a separate section in your Designation Letter called “Insurance Contour.”
3. When responding to your insurance contour, please provide us with updated revenue information relating to this Technology, as requested in your award. Also, if there have been any changes to your insurance policy, please provide us with up to date information.
